SCHOLARSHIP FOR GENERAL (CO-CURRICULAR) EXCELLENCE

Scholarships are offered to boys who demonstrate an outstanding potential to benefit from, contribute to, and influence others through the school's Academic Musical or broader Co-Curricular Programs. The focus of these different Scholarships is detailed below.

Scholarships attract a reduction in tuition fees only, as determined by the Headmaster. Scholarships continue while the student remains at Trinity, subject to the school's standard *Conditions of Entry* and also to periodical *Performance Reviews* through which the holder demonstrates exemplary standards of effort, progress, involvement, contribution and influence on his peers.

Scholarships for General (Co-Curricular) Excellence are offered to students entering Years 7 to 11 from outside the School, on the basis of a student profile and interview.

Applications are available in July. You must submit a profile of your son's achievements, together with the completed copy of the Application Form and the entry fee, by the due date.

The student's profile must demonstrate a balance between his talent in a range of Co-Curricular areas, his qualities of leadership, his willingness to become involved in all facets of school life and his academic potential.

Applications must include copy of the applicant's last two school reports. It is suggested that a reference be provided by the boy's current Principal or class teacher and a person relevant to the area of Co-Curricular excellence.

As part of the award process, all boys are invited in, together with their families, for an interview with the Selection Panel during late August or early September each year.

A Scholarship for General (Co-Curricular) Excellence is subject to a periodic performance review which addresses the criteria applicable to all scholarships at Trinity whilst laying particular emphasis on the standards in the School's Co-Curricular Policy.
