FACILITATION UPDATE No. 1 - 4 May 2018

The Community Consultation group completed its first task to appoint a facilitator for the initial process of consultation charter development. With the assistance of the unanimously appointed Facilitator, Danielle Huntersmith, the Community Consultation group has developed and signed the Charter on Thursday 26th April and agreed to move forward.

The aim of the Facilitation is set out in the Charter as:

“with the help of the Facilitator, to enable the Participants to consult with each other and with their respective Stakeholders in a productive way so as to identify and raise each of their issues relating to the School, explore such issues, understand each others’ points of view and so far as may be practicable develop a clear picture of those issues, and possible recommendations and solutions to be reported back to the School by the Facilitator for its consideration and possible implementation or further action”

The agreed plan going forward is firstly to develop within each individual stakeholder group a broad brush list of issues. Each member of the Community Consultation group (Participant) will be engaging with their Stakeholder members to obtain an understanding of their issues. Once this is done the issues will be brought back to the Community Consultation group.

The agreed outcomes of the first meeting were to ensure that the Community Consultation group engage Stakeholders in a broad, inclusive and consistent way in regards to identifying and understanding their issues. This is likely to involve the development of surveys / focus groups with targeted questions. Also the Community Consultation group is looking at how to ensure the integrity of the data. The group as a whole, will also look at solutions as to how to collate the data and design a summary with agreed time frames. A quantitative specialist has been invited to suggest the best way to address this.

Any survey participation will be limited to the Trinity Stakeholders and the Community Consultation group will provide regular updates through the Trinity website.
