

Music Scholarships (General Excellence)

Entry into Year 7 and above in 2025

Music plays an integral part in the education of our students at Trinity Grammar School. The Music Department has a long-standing tradition of excellence in music and offers tuition to many of our students. The information below provides you with important details regarding examination dates and requirements for music scholarship auditions.

AUDITION DATES

- · Applicants for Strings and Piano will be auditioned on Wednesday 21 February 2024 (during school hours)
- · Applicants for Woodwind, Brass and Percussion will be auditioned on Friday 23 February 2024 (during school hours)

WHO CAN AUDITION?

Applications are particularly encouraged from students presenting Flute, Bassoon, Trumpet, French Horn, Trombone, Tuba, Viola and Double Bass as well as other Strings, Piano, Woodwind, Brass and Percussion instruments.

It is important to note that applicants must have achieved the following AMEB levels (or equivalent):

If you are presenting a 2nd instrument – ONLY one short piece is required (maximum of 3 minutes in duration).



Music Scholarships (General Excellence)

AUDITION REQUIREMENTS

Students are required to present TWO (2) contrasting pieces. At least one of these pieces must be accompanied (students are responsible for organising their own accompanist on the day).

There are no technical exercises required but applicants will be tested on sight reading and aural skills equivalent to their AMEB standard.

Auditions will last approximately 15 minutes.

WHAT TO BRING ON THE DAY?

- A current passport photo (we will use this as part of our application form)
- TWO (2) copies of your pieces
- · Optional: any relevant information to support your application (certificates, letters of recommendation)
