Scholarships continue while the student remains at Trinity Grammar School, Kew, subject to the school's standard Conditions of Entry and are also subject to periodical performance reviews through which the holder must demonstrates exemplary standards of effort, progress, involvement, contribution and influence on his peers.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION TO HELP WITH YOUR PLANNING AND APPLICATION

This Means-Tested Scholarship is offered to a student entering Years 7 to 9 from outside the school, on the basis of a student profile and interview. Applications are open to students commencing in Year 7, 8 or 9 in 2025 who are not already enrolled at Trinity Grammar School, Kew

The Scholarship will be means-tested by submission of evidence of the need for financial assistance. At the time of applying a family must provide three copies of their most recent ATO tax return statements together with the completed Trinity Grammar School Fee Assistance Application form.

The scholarship may not be held in conjunction with any other scholarship or bursary.

This scholarship is not open to students who are currently attending the school.

Short-listed candidates only will be contacted for an interview.

The successful recipient will be of fine character and must be able to display a positive attitude to learning and be achieving at a satisfactory academic level; be able and willing to embrace the spirit and culture of the school and demonstrate that he would benefit from the opportunities that a Trinity Grammar School, Kew education would provide.

To support this application please include:

- · Last two school reports
- Last Naplan results
- Demonstration of participation in and contribution to the community

Under normal circumstances, the scholarship holder is expected to remain at the school until they complete Year 12. In the event of the student's withdrawal prior to this time, the full value of the scholarship to the time of their withdrawal will be repayable to the school by the parent/s accepting the scholarship on behalf of the holder.

On completion of the scholarship, it is expected that the recipient will write a report to the Principal outlining their experience at Trinity Grammar School, Kew. It is expected that, should the recipient of the scholarship ever be in a financial position to support the Trinity Grammar School Scholarship Fund in the future, they will consider doing so.

VALUE OF THE MEANS-TESTED SCHOLARSHIP

This means-tested scholarship will support up to 75 percent of tuition fee remission and will vary according to the calibre of candidates and number of scholarships offered.

Additional charges are payable for:

- · Compulsory school camps
- The provision of tablet computers and associated incidentals
- Some excursions
- · Private music lessons
- · School photographs

APPLICATION PROCESS

Please submit a profile of your son's achievements, together with the completed copy of the Application and Fee Assistance Form in person or via admissions@trinity.vic.edu.au, by the due date.

- The student's profile must demonstrate a balance between his talent in a range of cocurricular areas, his qualities of leadership, his willingness to become involved in all facets of school life and his academic potential.
- · Applications must include a copy of the applicant's last two school reports and the latest Naplan report.
- Two references are to be provided, one from the student's current Principal or class teacher and the other from a person associated with the students' extra curricular pursuits.
- · As part of the award process, short listed applicants are invited in, together with their families, for an interview.
- A means-tested scholarship is subject to a periodic performance review that addresses the criteria applicable to all
 scholarships at Trinity, whilst laying particular emphasis on the standards in the School's Cocurricular Policy.

Following the interview, if a place is available, you will receive a Confirmation of Enrolment form. To confirm the place, this form must be completed and returned together with the subsidised Enrolment Fee of \$500.
